Connect to everyday life: You might like to discuss with your children how Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection has brought us new life and hope in Him. When sad things happen to us, when we suffer, if we focus on Jesus and offer our suffering to Him then He will lift us up and fill us with His hope and love. Jesus, our King and Saviour, is indeed the source of our joy and hope!

# Sensory retelling of the Gospels

Why not read or retell the Gospel accounts of the Resurrection using visual aids? Here is an idea for The Empty Tomb (Luke 24:1-12). When the women go to the tomb with spices, you could hand around some spices to smell. Find a round stone to feel for when the women see the stone has been rolled away. You could use two Play Mobil figures for the angels (perhaps give them white cloaks). You could shake your head in disbelief when the disciples do not believe the women. And you could hand around a strip of white cloth/clean white pillow case for the linen cloths.


